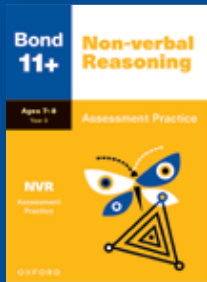
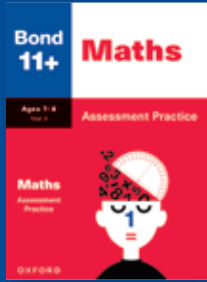
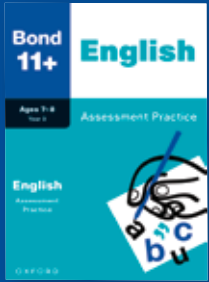


Sample spread from Non-verbal Reasoning ages 6-7

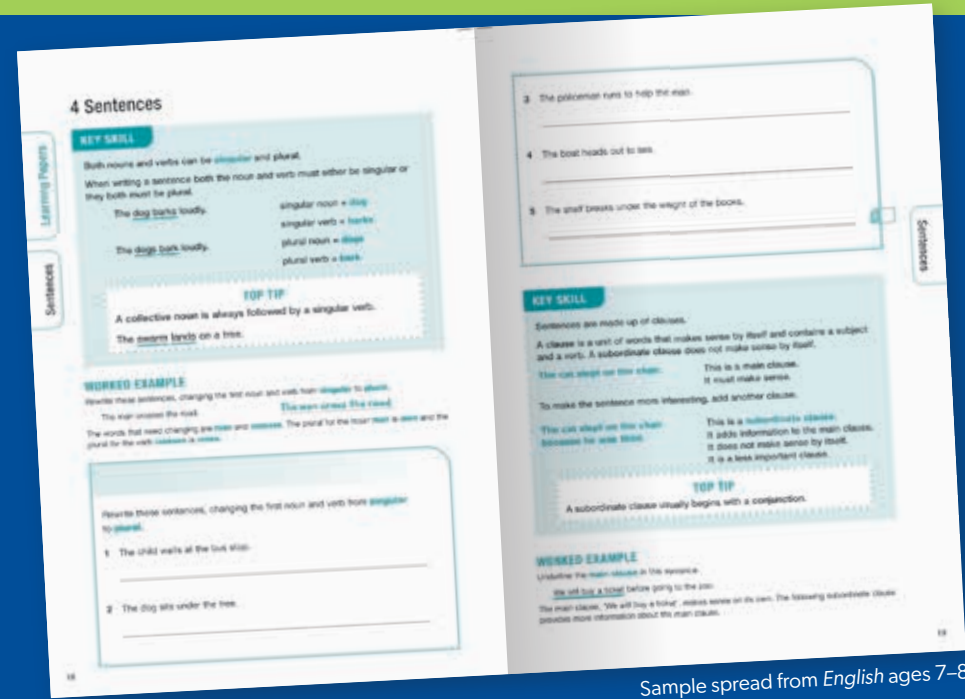

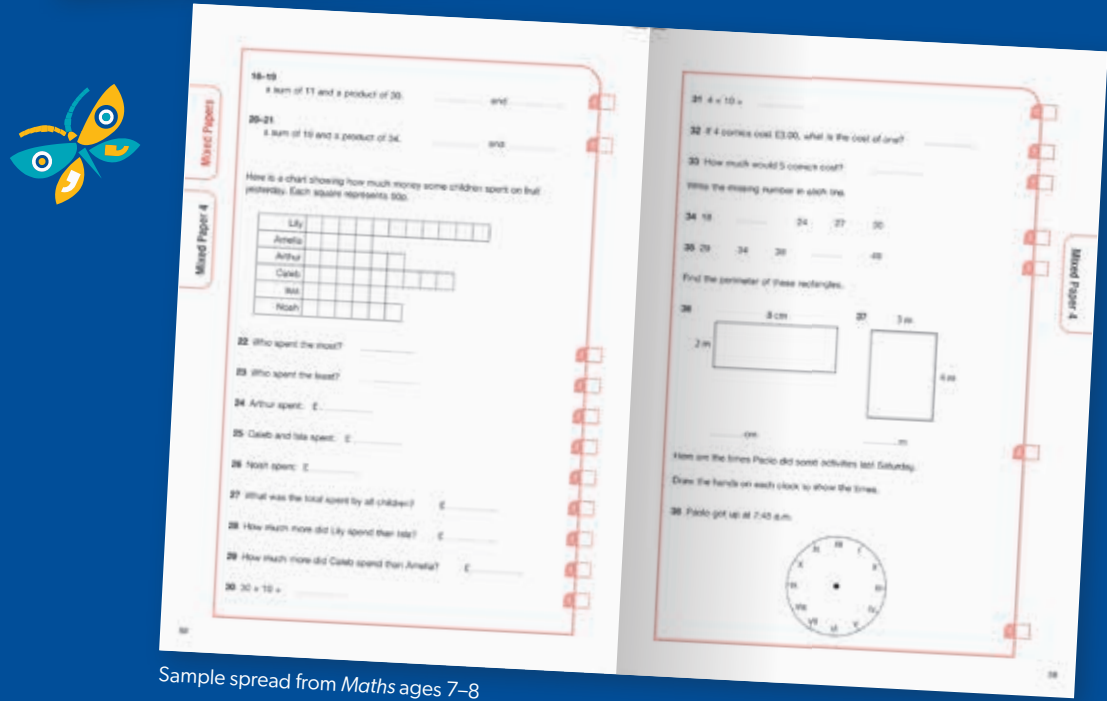

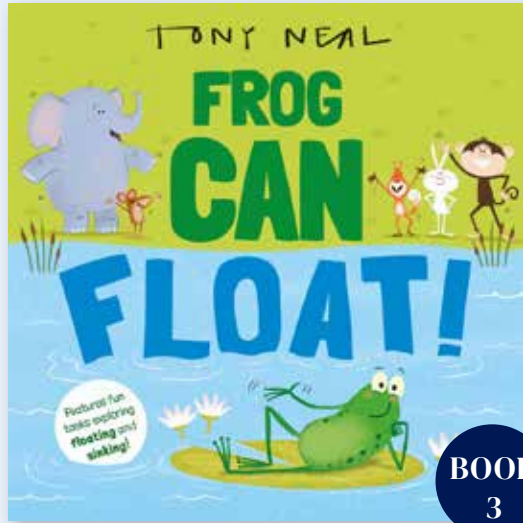
Sample spread from English ages 7-8
