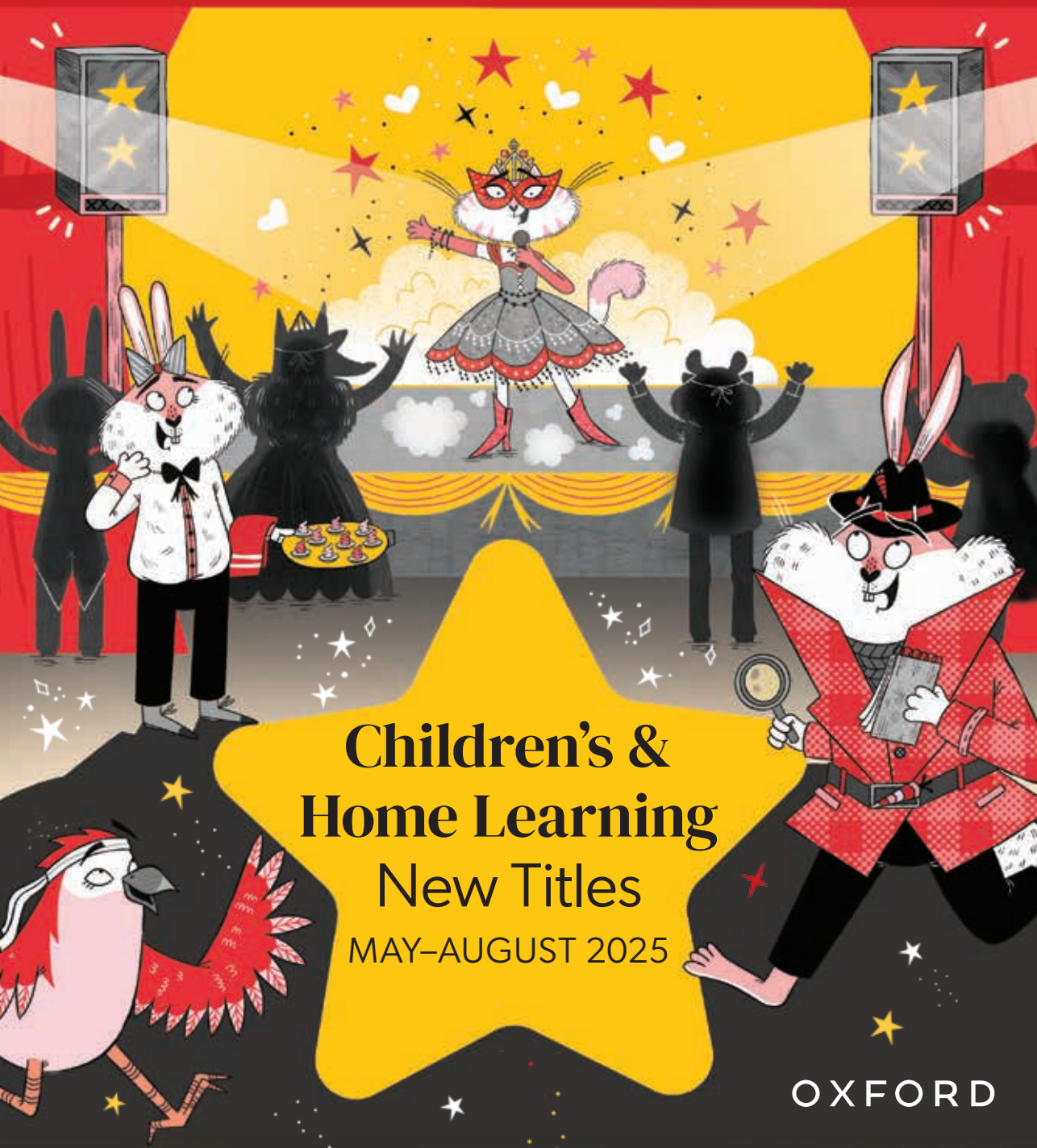

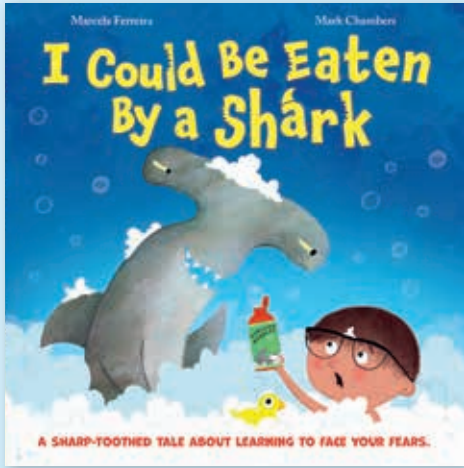

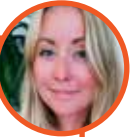

The Pebble Cove lighthouse stood on the clifftop above the town with its beam of its golden light swinging through the darkness.



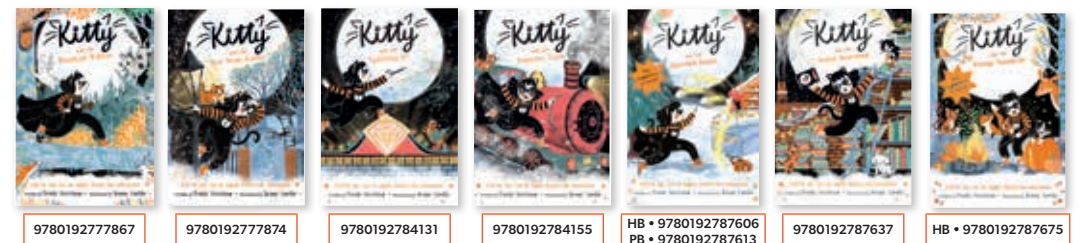
